On October 22, 2008, the Court continued the final pre-trial conference until December 2, 2008. But the Court did not address the dispositive motion deadline of November 17. In the past, when the Court has continued the pre-trial conference in this matter, it has also re-set the dispositive motion deadline for approximately 2-3 weeks after the pre-trial conference. Given the difficulty of filing a dispositive motion without the pre-trial order in place, does the Court plan to re-set the dispositive motion deadline as it has previously done? If so, December 19 would be agreeable to the defendants as the new dispositive motion deadline, if that date is amenable to the the Court. If you would like a formal motion or need anything further from the defendants, please let me know.
