SECOND MOTION TO COMPEL MEDIATION ORDERED ON 2/9/07

Comes now the petitioner, Samuel K. Lipari ("plaintiff") appearing *pro se* and respectfully requests that the court compel the defendants to initiate the mediation ordered by the court at the case management conference on February 09, 2007.

1. Mediation was ordered to be initiated by the defendants during the July 05, 2006 case management hearing.
2. The plaintiff repeatedly contacted the defendants' to participate in mediation but the defendants' counsel would not return calls or initiate the mediation.
3. Mediation was again ordered by the court on February 09, 2007 and agreed to without objection by the defendants' attorney Leonard L. Wagner MO Lic. # 39783.
4. The plaintiff repeatedly contacted the defendants' law firm Husch & Eppenberger, LLC but no mediation on the plaintiff's claims for redress has been scheduled.
5. Instead of mediating the defendants through their agents Seyfarth and Shaw LLC used a false pretext to have the plaintiff intimidated or placed in fear from being forced to travel to attend a deposition in Chicago Illinois, which has now been indefinitely postponed.

6. The defendants have shown that despite their representations to the court they will not engage in mediation in unless compelled to by this court.

5. The plaintiff is being kept out of the market for hospital supplies in the State of Missouri by the defendants' continuing efforts to prevent the plaintiff from obtaining redress.
